Why Do I Need a Seating Reservation for Church?

Due to the newest Oregon State mandate, our church is now allowed a maximum of 100 people per service. This number includes all volunteers and staff as well as seated attendees. By making your seating reservation as early as possible, you can be confident that there will be room for you. Please be aware that if you arrive Sabbath morning without a reservation, we may not be allowed to admit you due to already having reached maximum capacity. Here are three ways to access the weekly reservation form: 1) find the link on the red banner at the top of the church Grants Pass Church website - GrantsPassChurch.com; 2) access the form on the church calendar by clicking on the church event and following the link; 3) if you do not have internet access, call the church office before 3:00 PM on Thursdays. Please also note: The reservation form for each Sabbath will be open Monday - Thursday of the week leading up to that Sabbath. **The form will be disabled at 3:00 PM on Thursday, or earlier if our capacity is reached.**

Masks Required

Masks, face coverings or face shields are now required to be worn inside the building at all times. This includes when you are seated and walking in the foyer. This also pertains to any and all meetings in the church, not just church service. Face coverings are also required to be worn outside if a 6' distance can't be maintained.
