Why Do I Need a Seating Reservation for Church?

Due to the Oregon State mandate, our church is allowed a maximum of 100 people per service. ***Please be aware that if you arrive Sabbath morning without a reservation, we may not be allowed to admit you due to having already reached the maximum capacity.*** For information on how to reserve, please pick up the paper attached to the white board outside the church each week. The online reservation form for each Sabbath will open Monday of the week leading up to that Sabbath. ***The form will be disabled once our capacity is reached.*** If this happens, we encourage you to not be discouraged, but to still seek a Sabbath blessing through our live stream or at one of our sister churches.
