2ND ADVENT REWVAL MINISTRY

In September 2019, God began showing me different topics in Bible prophecy. I had a fascination for looking up hundreds of verses on various topics (such as prophecies on World History, Mystery Babylon, Mark of the Beast, etc.), finding as many as 20-40 verses on some of them. After 6 or 7 months of compiling the different topics, I came away with 24 different titles. Then I photocopied them and arranged them in order in a binder and handed them out to some of our Seventh-day Adventist friends that I knew had far more Bible knowledge than I had. At this time, I had been an Adventist for only about 2 years. My friends encouraged me, so I continued on. In the months following Covid-19, our country and church suffered some degree of shutdown, and we had to undergo changes in our interaction with our church members. We had a dinner and meeting at our house, where approximately 20 members came. I presented some ideas I had of the 2nd Advent Revival Ministry studies. Melissa Derfler offered her help to do the graphic design and layout, and later, Kerri Dobbins lent her editing expertise. Many people are now showing an interest and we believe this is going to be an exciting, growing ministry to get people ready and point them to the second coming of our Lord ~Lance Schmidt Jesus very soon!

I'm very excited as God is opening the doors for this new venture. People may wonder, "What's so special about another set of Bible studies?" These are Christcentered and concise. Each study is just one sheet of paper, with the verses on the back. Each point is firmly nailed down with lots of Scripture.

For a long time, I've had an interest in training young people to be missionaries for Jesus. Even children should be able to understand and explain the points of our faith, if presented in a clear and simple way—which these studies and presentations are. Since I do graphic design, I offered to work on illustrations and layout, and Kerri helped greatly with editing. God has been leading in remarkable ways.

The website was the next thing. At first when Lance asked me about it, I said that I was too busy. But God prompted me that this was something I needed to do!

Then God impressed me that the study sheets could be taken a step further and expanded into illustrated, interactive programs with question-and-answer format. These could be used for group dialog and home Bible studies. Each presentation has 50-60 slides, featuring beautiful art and Scripture verses that answer the questions. **Every topic must reveal the character of God** as proclaimed in the three angels' messages (see article on page 5).

Each member of the group actively participates in the study by finding the answers to the questions given, and marking the appropriate verses in their Bibles. This helps them to be able to locate these Scriptures later, and helps them make the study their own. The leader(s) have Presenter's Notes which tell what to say as each slide is being shown. When the health vision of 1863 was revealed to Mrs. White, she listed God's simple remedies as follows: pure air; pure water, sunshine, exercise, rest and proper nutrition. What was conspicuously absent from that list was "Trust in God". This omission was corrected 22 years later when in 1885, Mrs. White added as a natural remedy "a firm trust in God".

While good food, exercise, water etc., are all essential for good health, they are not sufficient. Only by complete trust in God can the cares of this world become light and give the peace of mind that allows all the natural remedies to do their work in unison.

The condition of the mind has much to do with the health of the physical system. If the mind is free and happy, under a consciousness of right-doing and a sense of satisfaction in causing happiness to others, it will create a cheerfulness that will react upon the whole system, causing a freer circulation of the blood and a toning up of the entire body. —Healthful Living p 233.8

Are you pessimistic, chronically worried, doubtful, stressed-out, and

ill at ease socially? You may be a Type D personality (D for distressed) and at higher risk of heart attack and other heart problems.

Johan Denollet, Ph.D., a professor of medical psychology at Tilburg University in the Netherlands, first proposed a Type D personality in the mid-1990s, after he and his colleagues observed that distressed heartattack survivors had higher short-term mortality rates than people with more upbeat personalities.

When one thinks about it, "Trust in God" is the only real antidote for a Type D personality. The Bible gives much counsel on the importance of a healthy mind and It warns us to guard against pessimistic, negative, self-centered and doubting thought patterns.

A sound heart [is] the life of the flesh: but envy the rottenness of the bones. Proverbs 14:30

Pleasant words [are as] an honeycomb, sweet to the soul, and health to the bones. Proverbs 16:24

A merry heart doeth good [like] a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones. Proverbs 17:22

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding... It shall be health to thy navel, and marrow to thy bones. Proverbs 3:5, 3:8

Doubt and Discouragement Induces Nervous Diseases

The assurance of God's approval will promote physical health. It fortifies the soul against doubt, perplexity, and excessive grief that so often sap the

vital forces and induce nervous diseases of a most debilitating and distressing character. –RH, Oct 16, 1883

(Colossians 1:13). If this is true, what excuse then have we for talking discouragement and unbelief and doubt—drawing darkness around us as a mantle? Let us roll back the dark shadow of doubt, casting it aside to be borne by Satan, the originator of all doubt and discouragement. —2MCP 674.3

The satisfaction you will realize in doing good will aid you greatly in the recovery of the healthy tone of the imagination. The pleasure of doing good animates the mind and vibrates through the whole body. —Healthful Living p 234

The pleasure of doing good to others imparts a glow to the feelings which flashes through the nerves, quickens the circulation of the blood, and induces mental and physical health. –4T, p. 56.

What the Third Angel's Message is Really About

You and I - Seventh-day Adventistshave been given trumpets and torches; we've been commissioned as watchmen and lightbearers. Why? God's given us a message - the final warning - for a world that is in its last throes of survival. These are the three angel's messages of Revelation 14. Don't expect to see real angels flying through the sky with parchment scrolls in their hands. According to 2SM 387, these angels are "a symbol to represent the people of God who are working in harmony with the universe of heaven." Wouldn't you like to be working with the universe of heaven? I would. The faces of those giving this message are going to "shine with the light of heaven" (LDE 201) and the message is going to "sound from one end of the earth to the other to prepare the way of the Lord." 6T 19

This is our second chance. In 1888, the "light that is to lighten the whole earth with its glory was resisted" (1SM 234) as Satan roused determined opposition to the preaching of E. J. Waggoner and A.T. Jones on righteousness by faith. Ellen White called it "a most precious message" (TM 91) basically stating that "it presented justification through faith" and "invited the people to receive the righteousness of Christ, which is made manifest in obedience to all the commandments of God" ibid. She said it was "the message that God commanded to be given to the world. It is the third angel's message". Was it proclaimed? Just the opposite - it was rejected. And Seventh-day

Adventists, like the Israelites of old, went back to wander in the wilderness from 1888 till now, instead of going into the promised land. So here we are again.

Why is this message so important? Because we are Laodiceans. (Rev. 3:14-19) Poor, blind, naked Laodiceans. Laodiceans who need the robe of Christ's righteousness so we can appear in God's presence. Should we start sewing? No. This robe "woven in the loom of heaven, has in it not one thread of human devising. Christ in His humanity wrought out a perfect


I will greatly rejoice in the Lord, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for He has clothed me with the garments of salvation, He has covered me with the robe of righteousness...Is. 61:10


character, and this character He offers to impart to us. 'All our righteousnesses are as filthy rags.' Is. 64:6. Everything that we of ourselves can do is defiled by sin. But the Son of God 'was manifested to take away our sins; and in him is no sin.'

Sin is defined to be 'the transgression of the law.' I John 3:5,4. But Christ was obedient to every requirement of the law... By His perfect obedience He has made it possible for every human being to obey God's commandments". Here's the miracle: "When we submit ourselves to Christ, the heart is united with His heart, the will is merged in His will, the mind becomes one with His mind, the thoughts are brought into captivity to Him; we live His life. This is what it means to be clothed with the garment of His righteousness". Then when God looks at us, He sees the perfect righteousness of His own Son. What an awesome trade! It's called justification by faith.

Ellen White said several people had written to her, asking "if the message of justification by faith is the third angel's message, and, she said, "I have answered, It is the third angel's message in verity." RH 4/1/1890.

Many churches today are teaching that it's impossible for us to actually keep the commandments of God. But we are told, "The conditions of eternal life, under grace, are just what they were in Eden - perfect righteousness, harmony with God, perfect conformity to the principles of His law." MB 76. How can we ever accomplish that? We can't - at least, not in our own feeble strength. It's ALL THROUGH FAITH IN JESUS. All about Him. Our own efforts won't cut it, anymore than Cain's offering of fruit way back at the gates of Eden. Like Abel, who brought a lamb showing his faith in Jesus, our only hope and claim to anything is though the blood of the Lamb who died so we might live. His sacrifice was enough. His grace is sufficient - for me, for you, for the world He died to save. That's what it's about. ~Melissa Derfler





Alta Cummings was born in the little logging town of Scotia, in the heart of the California Redwoods. She was the youngest child in the family and had two older brothers. Even though she was a 4th generation Adventist on both sides of her family, her parents had stopped going to church or practicing their beliefs by the time their children were born. Alta's grandparents took her to Sabbath School sporadically when she was young, but she was not with them often enough for it to become a regular part of her life.

Alta's father worked in the logging industry and the family lived in several small towns around Northern California while she was growing up. Even though there was no religion practiced in their home, and the world was very much a part of her life, there was one thing that she always remembered: when Friday night came, she knew it was the Sabbath.

Chuck Austin began his life in El Paso, Texas, but due to his father's job as a chief mechanic with the Air Force, the family lived in ten different places all around the country for the first

and each of them was born in a different town. The family finally settled in the Chicago, Illinois, area when Chuck was nine years old. His parents were Baptists, and they attended Sunday School and church together as a family for several years, but when Chuck became a teenager, he decided that he'd much rather spend Sundays playing ball with his friends. He didn't outright rebel, but silently sabotaged his mother's efforts to get to church on time. She finally gave up, and at that point the family quit going to church.

Toward the end of Chuck's senior year of high school, a friend told Chuck how the Lord had changed his life. That night, in his room at home, he asked the Lord to come into his life. Unfortunately, his new-found experience lasted only till midway through his first year of college and, for the next eleven years, sports and partying with his friends were the only things that mattered.

Chuck earned a B.S. in Law Enforcement, thinking that he wanted to work with juvenile offenders. But when he

graduated, he decided that he would like to do some traveling

before settling down, so he took a job in roofing for a year, intending to go back to an internship that would allow him to enter work with young people. At the end of that year, he took a job with a printing company and ended up working with them for the next ten years. During that time he also married, and he and his wife continued in the party life style.

One day a co-worker told Chuck about a Bible study that he had started going to. He said that the people he was studying with went to church on Saturday. Chuck was worried that his friend was getting into a cult and determined that he would go to the Bible study to save his friend from these strange ideas. He soon realized that what was being taught was from the Bible and that relieved his mind about his friend getting tangled up with a strange group. Since he wasn't really interested in continuing with the study he quit going.

Awhile later he was told about a prophecy seminar coming up,

and, since he had an interest in prophecy (he believed in the rapture, and followed some of the well-known charismatic preachers of the time), he decided to attend. It was a seminar by Mark Finley, and at the end of the series Chuck was baptized and ioined the Adventist Church. It wasn't long, however, until his wife tired of his no longer doing the things that she enjoyed, so she left him. Chuck was devastated, but the Lord used that experience to truly convert his heart and he formed a new relationship with Jesus.

After Chuck's conversion, he and a couple of friends started a Country Life health food store and restaurant that they operated for three years. During this time, Chuck was also a lay speaker for the Illinois Conference, and traveled to different churches to preach.

In the meantime, Alta had married and she and her husband were living on the same property as Alta's parents. They decided that they should be attending church again so they all took Bible studies together. At the end of the studies, Alta and her parents were all baptized but her husband wasn't baptized until a few years later. Alta and her husband eventually had two sons, but unfortunately the marriage didn't last and she found herself a single parent.

Chuck had tired of life in the big city, and was longing to work in some kind of ministry in the country. He had been praying that the Lord would show him what he could do to accomplish that, when he got a phone call from an old friend who had moved out West some time before. His friend had heard about Chuck's desire to live in the country, and he happened to

looking for a caretaker for their property in Rackerby, a tiny town in Northern California. Chuck told him that he had been praying about a way to move to the country just the day before, and Chuck saw this as the answer to his prayer. He ended up moving to northeastern California and working there for the next year. As there was no Adventist church in Rackerby, he drove to Brownsville, just a short distance away, on Sabbath.It also just happened to be the church where Alta and her family attended.

Alta's boys fell in love with Chuck before Alta and Chuck realized what was happening in their own hearts. It didn't take long, however, before they knew that they wanted to spend the rest of their lives together. It will be thirty years so far on December 30!

After they married, Chuck decided that he would go back into the printing business. After moving to Idaho and then back to Chicago, they decided they would rather be on the west coast. The type of printing business that Chuck was in, called "pre-press," was very specialized. He had become the project (production) coordinator for the company he worked for. While they wanted to live in the country, they thought they would probably need to be within commuting distance of a large city for Chuck to be able to have a job. So they were both really surprised one day when Chuck saw an ad for someone with his skills to work in Grants Pass. They were soon on their way here, and it's been 24 years now and counting.

Alta had homeschooled her boys, but when they grew older she was asked to be the Grants Pass Church secretary. After much prayer she told Pastor Clark that she would take the job for six know of an older couple who was 7 months. This job had never been

something that she had wanted to do, but it wasn't long until she began to enjoy her work, and it became evident that it was the Lord's plan for her. She continued in this position until her retirement eleven years later, in 2017.

In 2008 Chuck was laid off from the printing company, as prepress work was being phased out in favor of all-in-one printing production. His desire to work in ministry had never left him, and it was shortly thereafter that he was offered a position as Bible Worker and Pastoral Assistant for Pastor Clark. With the exception of a year spent living in Chicago to help his parents at a difficult time in their lives, he has been functioning in that capacity ever since. He is grateful to the Lord for letting him have a part in reaching others with the message of Jesus' love, seeing them make decisions for Christ, and then being baptized. His dream of ministry has come true.

Chuck and Alta had thought that when they retired, they would probably move back to her family property in Brownsville, and spend their winters in Arizona. But God had other plans as they unexpectedly became grandparents, and now can't imagine not being close to their granddaughter for her growing up years. They are busy filling the role in her life that Alta's grandparents filled in hers when she was young. So we are blessed to be able to have Chuck and Alta here with us for the foreseeable future. They feel blessed that the Lord brought them together and has allowed them to do ministry together all these years. The Lord has a way of working things out that we would never have dreamed, as long as we follow His will for our lives.
