A Change is Coming next Sabbath

A day many of you have been looking for has come. Starting next Sabbath, January 16, you will **not** need to make reservations for church. This new adjustment to our weekly gathering will continue as long as it continues, as we are subject to different OHA rule changes.

Things could also change if, with our new freedom, we fail to maintain the appropriate physical spacing and proper wearing of face coverings. As such, we need to be keenly aware of our seating choices in order to maximize how many people can attend church. For example, if a couple sits in the center of a shorter pew, no one else will be able to sit in that pew while still maintaining a 6-foot distance between households. But if that couple were to sit at one end of the pew, then there would be space for a single visitor to sit at the other end of that pew while maintaining the required distance. We hope this encourages many of you.
