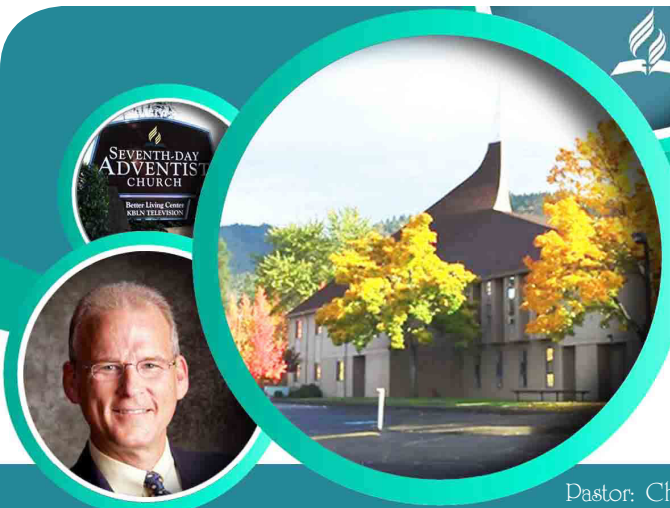

Ellen White's contribution to integrate health reform into Adventist theology came at a time when the medical treatment of the day could not adequately deal with contagious diseases, poor hygiene and nutrition, high infant mortality and the sickness and death as the result of poisonous medicines, such as strychnine, opium, arsenic and others used in practice.



She writes, ***"I was shown that more deaths have been caused by drug-taking than from all other causes combined. If there was in the land one physician in the place of thousands, a vast amount of premature mortality would be prevented. Multitudes of physicians, and multitudes of drugs, have cursed the inhabitants of the earth, and have carried thousands and tens of thousands to untimely graves"***. Spiritual Gifts, vol. 4a, p. 133.

In vision, she was shown the harmful substances mentioned, along with tobacco, alcohol, tea and coffee, the stimulants that lessen vitality and eat away at our spirituality. In an all-encompassing vision in 1863 she wrote, ***"I saw that it was a sacred duty to***

attend to our health, and arouse others to their duty. . . . We have a duty to speak, to come out against intemperance of every kind—intemperance in working, in eating, in drinking, and in drugging—and then point them to God's great medicine: water, pure soft water, for diseases, for health, for cleanliness, and for luxury."



" . . . I saw that we should not be silent upon the subject of health but should wake up minds to the subject." Selected Messages, book 3, p. 280. She also wrote: ***"The work God requires of us will not shut us away from caring for our health. The more perfect our health, the more perfect will be our labor."*** p. 279. Ellen White viewed health as essential to fit people for the second coming of Christ. ***"Heaven is all health"***. p. 172.

Ellen White emphasized natural remedies and a healthful lifestyle, but was not afraid to take advantage of modern medical expertise when natural treatments were not enough, especially

during the latter part of her life. She urged that the Seventh-day Adventist Church provide the very best medical training for medical personnel at the College of Medical Evangelists (now Loma Linda University), and that the school should meet the very highest standards of medical practice.

Over the years, many of the simple therapies and practices, such as hydrotherapy and massage have been abandoned for cutting edge advances in disease management. Hyperbaric oxygen therapy is a treatment option at Loma Linda and Proton cancer therapy. Independent medical ministries have and are an important outreach for Adventist evangelism and health promotion within the church and to the community. The NEW START program at Weimar is an example of a preventative and remedial treatment center based on Adventist health principles.

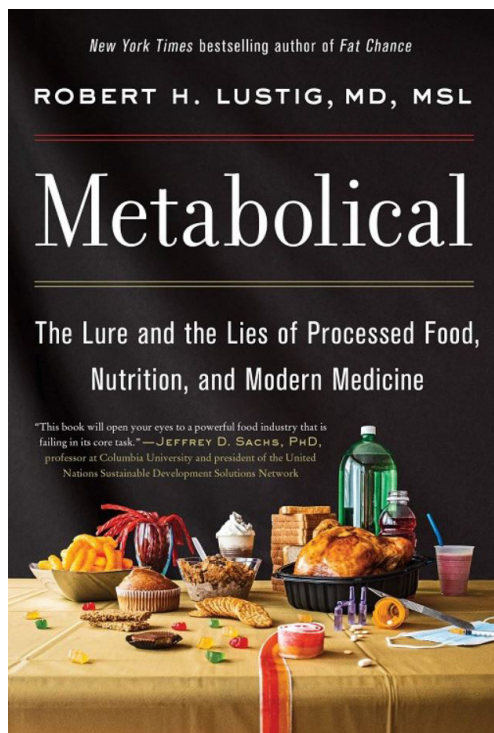
Remember that health is a summation of our physical, mental, emotional and spiritual state of being. When one or more areas are negatively affected, the whole being is affected. To treat one part as an isolated entity is to neglect the integrated, homogenous whole. That is why an ounce of prevention is worth more than a pound of cure, . . . and walking past donuts gathers no pounds either.

"Pure air, sunlight, abstemiousness, rest, exercise,

proper diet, the use of water, trust in divine power—these are the true remedies. Every person should have a knowledge of nature's remedial agencies and how to apply them.—Counsels on Health p. 90.

“In the Saviour’s manner of healing there were lessons for His disciples. On one occasion He anointed the eyes of a blind man with clay, and bade him, ‘Go, wash in the pool of Siloam. . . . He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.’ John 9:7. The cure could be wrought only by the power of the Great Healer, yet Christ made use of the simple agencies of nature. While He did not give countenance to drug medication, He sanctioned the use of simple and natural remedies.”—Desire of Ages, p. 824



As for drug therapy today—

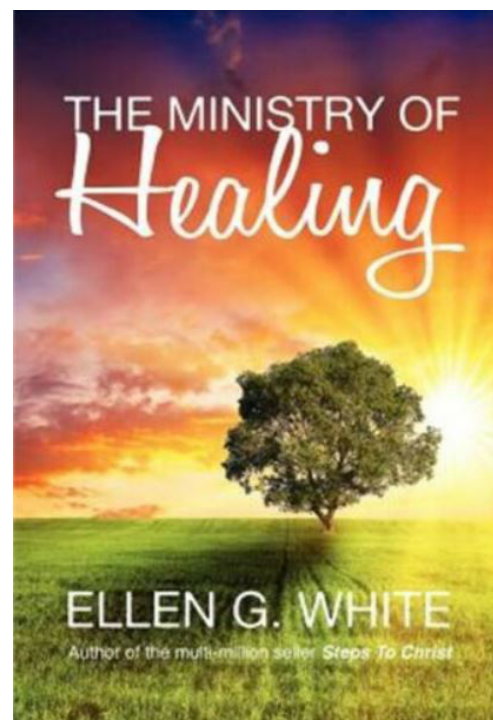
Dr. Robert Lustig, a pediatric endocrinologist and Professor Emeritus at the University of California, San Francisco, has written a number of excellent books about health. His latest, *“Metabolical: The Lure and the Lies of Processed Food, Nutrition, and Modern Medicine”* goes deep into the details of how changes in our

food supply have damaged our metabolic health. In summary, it boils down to two primary key issues or problems. The first is that the medical establishment doesn't want you to know that drugs were never intended or designed to treat the foundational cause of chronic disease. They merely treat the symptoms.

“In the book, I make it very clear that modern medicine has two factions, two paradigms,” Lustig says. *“One is treatment of acute disease, and for the most part, they’ve gotten it reasonably right. I was part of that system for 40 years and was comfortable within it. But for chronic disease, Type 2 diabetes, hypertension, lipid problems, cardiovascular disease, cancer, dementia, nonalcoholic fatty liver disease, polycystic ovarian disease — all of which are chronic metabolic diseases, all of which are mitochondrial diseases — we don’t have anything. We have symptomatic relief only. Same thing with hypertension, osteoporosis and autoimmune disease. All of these, we have symptomatic treatments. We don’t cure or reverse the disease; we just treat the symptoms. And so the disease gets worse”.*

In his book, Lustig presents the history of our food and medical systems. A significant part of why medical doctors are clueless about health today is because Big Pharma was placed in charge of their education. The drug industry, in turn, was a distinct profit-making scheme from its beginning. In 1910, Abraham Flexner, an educator, wrote the Flexner Report, which turned out to be a turning point in terms of creating evidence-based modern medicine, while simultaneously eliminating many health-related factors, including nutrition and preventive medicine. His brother, Simon Flexner, a pathologist and pharmacist, was the first president of Rockefeller University. One of the reasons the Flexner Report eliminated certain aspects of medicine was because

John D. Rockefeller, president of Standard Oil, was also in the pharmaceutical business. He was



trying to sell coal tar, a byproduct of oil refining, as a treatment for a range of ailments. So, Rockefeller was seeking new profit avenues.

“He basically said we have to get drugs and especially coal tar into the hands of physicians who can prescribe it,” Lustig says. The only way to do that was by overhauling the medical system and shifting the focus to pharmaceuticals. *“So that was the start of Big Pharma. That’s not the story they want to tell, but that is in fact the case.”* This account is echoed in the history of modern medicine, and the suppression of many curative and inexpensive natural therapies, hailed falsely as quackery. Don't just take my word on this. Look it up!

Please take time to read, **The Ministry of Healing**, by E. G. White. It will outline God's way to health and healing, to direct the mind away from the institutions of men that enslave, and to set free the seeking soul in the hope and promise of the perfect remedy in this life and beyond! Blessings and excellent health to all!

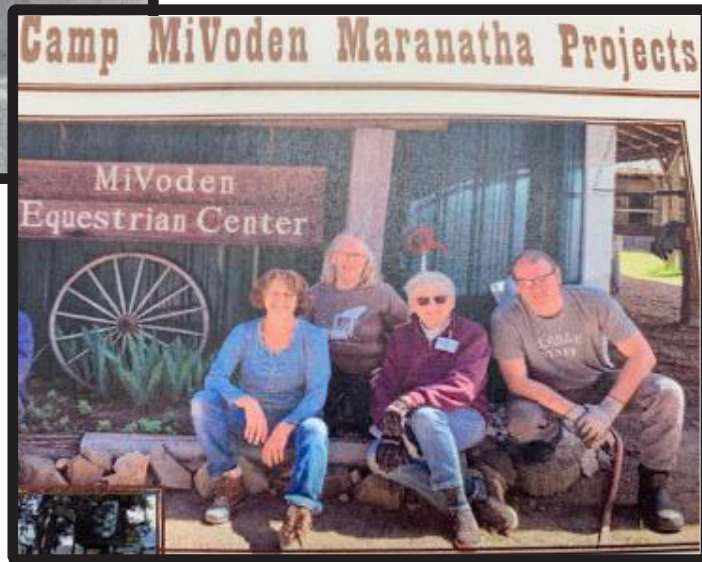
JOAN PETERSON VOLUNTEERS FOR MARANATHA PROJECT AT CAMP MIVODEN



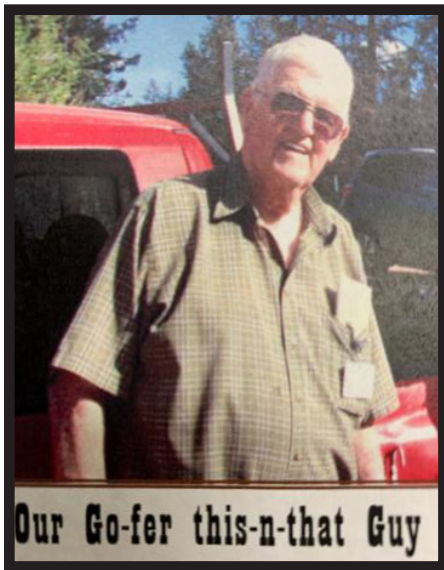

lay up their treasure here and fix their affections upon earthly things. We must do our utmost to prevent those who labor in God's cause from obtaining means to use against us. **Keep the money in our own ranks.**

The more means they obtain, the more they will injure our kingdom by taking from us our subjects. Make them care more for money than for the upbuilding of Christ's kingdom and the spread of the truths we hate, and we need not fear their influence; for we know that every selfish, covetous person will fall under our power, and will finally be separated from God's people.

"Through those that have a form of godliness but know not the power, we can gain many who would otherwise do us harm.

Lovers of pleasure more than lovers of God will be our most

effective helpers.

Those of this class who are apt and intelligent will serve as decoys to draw others into our snares. Many will not fear their influence, because they profess the same faith. We will thus lead them to conclude that the requirements of Christ are less strict than they once believed, and that by conformity to the world they would exert a greater influence with worldlings. Thus they will separate from Christ; then they will have no strength to resist our power, and ere long they will be ready to ridicule their former zeal and devotion.

"Until the great decisive blow shall be struck, our efforts against commandment keepers must be untiring.

We must be present at all

their gatherings. In their large meetings especially our cause will suffer much, and we must exercise great vigilance, and employ all our seductive arts to **prevent souls from hearing the truth and becoming impressed by it.**

"I will have upon the ground, as my agents, men holding false doctrines mingled with just enough truth to deceive souls. I will also have unbelieving ones present who will express doubts in regard to the Lord's messages of warning to His church. Should the people read and believe these admonitions, we could have little hope of overcoming them. But if we can divert their attention from these warnings, they will remain ignorant of our power and cunning, and we shall secure them in our ranks at last. God will not permit His words to be slighted with impunity. If we can keep souls deceived for a time, God's mercy will be withdrawn, and He will give them up to our full control.

"We must cause **distraction and division.** We must destroy their anxiety for their own souls, and **lead them to criticize,**

to judge, and to accuse and condemn one another, and to cherish selfishness and enmity. For these sins, God banished us from His presence; and all who follow our example will meet a similar fate."

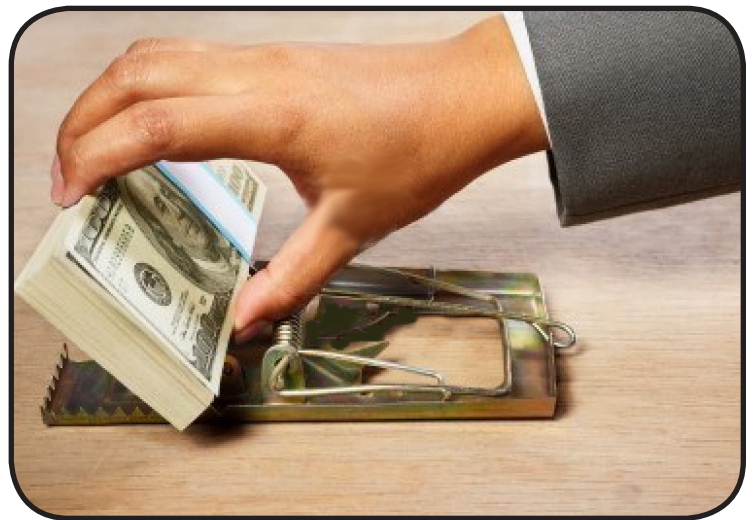

with those who will not swerve from their allegiance to God. We led the Romish church to inflict imprisonment, torture, and death upon those who refused to yield to her decrees; and now that we are bringing the Protestant churches and the world into harmony with this right arm of our strength, we will finally have a law to exterminate all who will not submit to our authority. **When death shall be made the penalty of violating our sabbath, then many who are now ranked with commandment keepers will come over to our side.**

"But before proceeding to these extreme measures, we must exert all our wisdom and subtlety to deceive and ensnare those who honor the true Sabbath. We can separate many from Christ by **worldliness, lust, and pride.** They may think themselves safe because they believe the truth, but **indulgence of appetite or the lower passions,** which will confuse judgment and destroy discrimination, will cause their fall.

"Go, **make the possessors of lands and money drunk with the cares of this life.**

Present the world before them in its most attractive light, that they may

Pastor's Page



Have you ever wondered what parts of the Bible are the most important to study?

Depending on whom you ask, you may get different suggestions. Some may emphasize prophetic passages in Daniel and Revelation, others may emphasize passages about Righteousness by Faith in Romans. Still others may emphasize passages about the Sanctuary, from Leviticus or Hebrews. All of these are good answers, but what suggestion might you have gotten if you'd asked Ellen White about it? She certainly recommended studying many different parts of the Bible but, if you do a search through her entire writings looking for the chapters she most often recommended for study, you may be surprised to learn that there are two chapters that stand head and shoulders above the rest. The two chapters she recommended most — about 40 times, in fact — are John 17 and Isaiah 58.

John 17 is Jesus' final recorded prayer before the crucifixion; in it He prays not only for His disciples, but for everyone who would ever believe in Him. There is much deep theology packed into this chapter, and of particular interest is Jesus' prayer for unity among His people. He didn't merely pray that we would be one — He prayed "that they may be made perfect in one, and that the world may know that You have sent Me." (Jn. 17:23) "Perfect in one." What kind of unity that must be! Through this oneness, God's glory would be seen among us. How could such unity be

achieved among so many differing human beings? Only when the last verse of the chapter is fulfilled, when Jesus prayed, "that the love with which You loved Me may be in them, and I in them." (Jn. 17:26)

Isaiah 58 is a passage that many Adventists have partially memorized because it mentions the Sabbath. However, if you study the whole chapter, it is actually about what true religion entails. God says that true religion is not merely about fasting and prayer, but about putting the love of God into action. True religion is to free those oppressed by sin, to share food and clothing with the hungry and naked, and to invite the poor into your home. When God's people finally do this, God promises, "Then your light shall break forth like the morning, Your healing shall spring forth speedily...Then you shall call, and the LORD will answer; You shall cry, and He will say, 'Here I am.'" (Isaiah 58:8, 9)

There are many vitally important truths in Scripture but no matter how well we may know these truths, none of it matters unless the love of Jesus is perfected in our hearts and reflected in how we treat the people we like the least. I believe this is the reason Ellen White recommended these two passages more than any other. The love of Christ — the love that moved Jesus to compassionately touch the filthy, the love that moved Jesus to wash the feet of Big-Mouth Peter, Angry James, and Back-stabbing Judas, the love that moved Jesus to surrender His life to offer the world that killed Him

a chance at eternal life — that love is what God is waiting to see reproduced among His people. The day that radical love is embraced by the church will be the day that the light will break forth like the morning!
